ABOUT PRISM





- below and above-grade waterproofing;
- inside walls air barriers, vapor barriers, and insulation;
- roofing reflective, photovoltaics, materials (membranes, films, elastomeric coatings, BUR, SPF, single-ply, metal), coverings, and green roofs;
- and exteriors EIFS, masonry, concrete, SIPs, windows, glazes, films, curtain walls, living walls and landscape design.

PRISM's mission is to disseminate information on the sustainable built environment in one publication, PRISM, and to further the cause of sustainable building in hopes that information published today will contribute to sustainable and resilient buildings tomorrow. Our belief is that sharing and collaborating with each other can add value to a sustainable future while ensuring the preservation of the past.
